

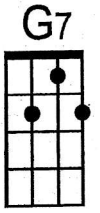
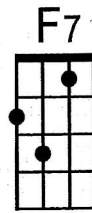
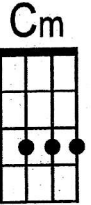
CAJUN MOON

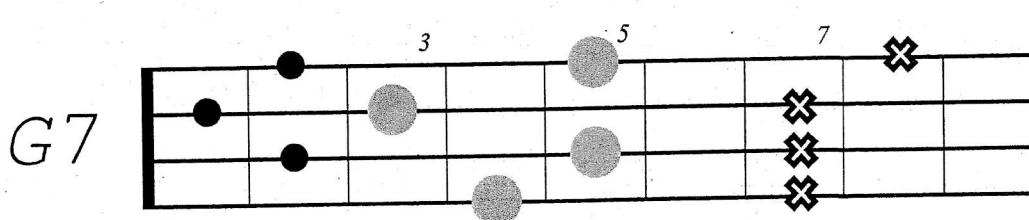
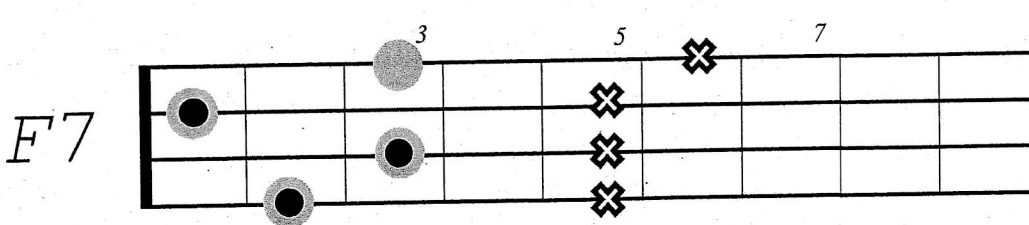
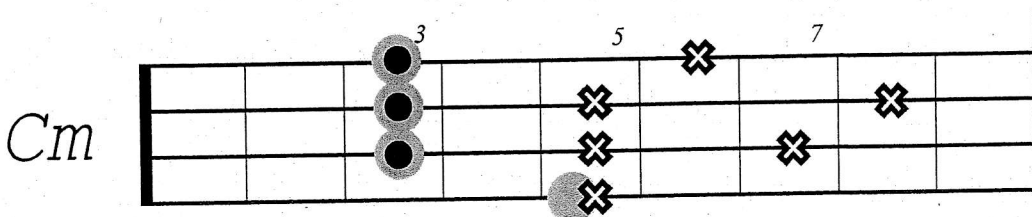
SOFT CHORUS UNDER INSTRUMENTAL IMPROVISATION
